

The Bartow-Pell Mansion Museum and Gardens

Both a New York City and a National Landmark in Pelham Bay Park, BPMM's history dates to 1654 when Englishman Thomas Pell purchased 9,000 acres of what is today the Bronx and lower Westchester County from the Siwanoy Indians. For visitors, the highlight is the 1830s mansion with its glorious Greek Revival interiors built by Pell descendent Robert Bartow. The site also includes a 19th-century carriage house, an 18th-century Pell cemetery, a 20th-century formal garden, and even an authentic Native American wigwam. Park trails along the shore of Long Island Sound surround the property.

Opened as a museum in 1946, BPMM is a public/private partnership between the City of New York Department of Parks & Recreation and the Bartow-Pell Conservancy, and is a member of the Historic House Trust of New York City.

The Bartow-Pell Conservancy

The mission of the Bartow-Pell Conservancy is to create a vibrant cultural site through the preservation, restoration, and interpretation of the only remaining 19th-century country estate on Pelham Bay. This is achieved by protecting, preserving, and restoring the site's architecture, landscape, and collections; interpreting its history in compelling and innovative ways; and creating dynamic education programs for schools, adults, and families.
